These kids (some who are turning 50 this year) and their parents set the strong foundation for SKIP to be the group it is today. During the early years we had amazing support from Gov. Joe Ada and Tony Lamorena who gave us the boost we needed to get Guam recognized in the Dance World. In addition, we know that the only way to thank Phil Flores for his continuous generosity is to work to be the best we can be in everything we do.

The creation of SKIP was never about dance. It was started to give and provide something productive to participate in and have fun. It was and continues to be a place to teach respect, giving your best in everything you do, commitment, team work, support of each other, self confidence, time management, love of God, and the list could go on and on. # SKIP HISTORY

The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) is a GUAM SUCCESS STORY! SKIP originally started as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated in 1982, known as the Sunshine Kids in Production (SKIP). Prior to the birth of SKIP, Children's Productions staged a number of children's musicals. Soon the focus turned to dance, giving thousands of Guam's youth an opportunity to excel. Instructors and choreographers continue to come to Guam from Los Angeles and New York City to work with Guam's best. We want to especially thank all who have come to Guam to give our dancers the best training in the world! The list of choreographers who have come to Guam to choreograph for the SKIP Entertainment Company are the Who's Who of Dance including Ray Leeper, Tina D'Amato, Tabita & Napoleon Dumo, Dee Caspary, Tony Czar, Tucker Barkley, Andre Fuentes (RIP), Ambrose Respicio, Gabe deGuzman, and many more.

The SKIP Dancers began touring in 1985 when the first group toured the U.S. Mainland and since that time have traveled to dance competitions and performances in the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe and Australia every year. In 1991, members of SKIP performed on International Star Search, aired in over 63 countries. Later that year, SKIP was once again selected to appear on Ed McMahon's Star Search. That same year, SKIP dancers appeared on the cover of PERFORMER'S EDGE, a national dance publication. From 1991 through 2010, SKIP has won numerous National and International Dance Championships. One of the most exciting competitions was during the 1996 Jazz Dance World Congress held at the Kennedy Center where SKIP won the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award. Due to this honor, SKIP was selected as featured performers at the 1997 Jazz Dance World Congress in Weisbaden, Germany. International recognition was brought back to Guam once again when SKIP was honored by winning the Overall Dance Championship at the International Grand Prix Dance Festival in Cesena, Italy in July 2002, the Canadian National Finals in 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016 and the Czech Republic Dance Festival in 2007. In 2014, SKIP represented Guam at one of the most difficult and prestigious competition showcases in the world - the PULSE Showcase in Las Vegas. The judges included Brian Friedman and Chris Judd. SKIP won one of the top awards and was invited back as a guest to showcase. In 2014, the group once again won the championship at the European Grand Prix in Barcelona Spain and performed at the prestigious HEAVEN beach club in Marbella Spain.

During the past several years, SKIP has continued to win top awards in five countries including the US, Canada, Australia, Czech Republic and Italy. SKIP was also selected to audition for America's Best Dance Crew and made it through to the final selection. For the past several years, SKIP dancers have teamed up with dancers from the US and Australia as a part of EMPIRE, THE CREW to win the Championships at the Battlegrounds Hip Hop Competitions in Australia.

The group has become well known on youtube - again representing Guam. During this past year - the choreography of Brian Esperon along with the SKIP Dancers has been recognized by DanceOn Network numerous times throughout this year as one of the top 5 choreographers (worldwide) of the week. He has also been recognized by Chris Brown, Nicki Minaj, Cardi B and Jason Derulo. In addition SKIP dancers were featured on the latest Steve Aoki Music Video. These are huge honors for our island dancers to be recognized as some of the best in the world.

SKIP has also been named as one of the top 50 dance studios in the entire United States by Dance Teacher magazine. Thousands from around the world are able to read about Guam's very own, SKIP Entertainment Company.

In October, 2016 SKIP added a second state of the art studio beginning a new chapter of training for the students on Guam including the new ballet program under the direction of Co-Director Francesca Ambrose. The future continues to be bright for Guam's up and coming dancers.

In the summer of 2018, SKIP won the coveted Showbiz Group Icon Award which is earned by the group receiving the highest score of the entire National Finals in Anaheim.

We did have a tough year as this is the first year we have lost any of our touring company dancers; Sean Wade and Dominic Cadiz. Both contributed so much to the organization and will forever be missed.

This summer, SKIP has been selected to represent Guam at the Dance World Cup being held in Braga, Portugal. According to the Dance World Cup organizers, over 20,000 competitors from 61 countries will be competing for the championship. This will be the first time for SKIP to be in Portugal where the best dancers from around the world come to compete and make lifelong friendships.

# CHOREOGRAPHER BRIAN ESPERON



Brian Esperon first started dancing at the age of 8 with SKIP Entertainment Company, competing and performing around the United States, Prague, Canada, Italy, Japan, Spain, and Australia. At the age of 16, he started choreographing for SKIP and won his first National Choreography Award. Brian's choreography has lead SKIP to win multiple dance championships across the United States, from California, Florida, and Las Vegas. He then graduated Magna Cum Laude from Loyola Marymount University with a degree in dance and studio arts and has worked with choreographers Andres Fuentes, Erica Sobol, Tony Tzar, Willda-beast Adams, and Matt Steffanina while living in Los Angeles. Brian has appeared in music videos with artists including Steve Aoki, Bruno Mars, Maroon 5, Ingrid Michaelson, and Bethany Mota and was a Las Vegas Finalist on So You Think You Can Dance. He has choreographed and performed for companies on Guam including MAC Cosmetics, Cars Plus, Breitling, and The Make-A-Wish foundation and opened for artists such as Kehlani, Iyaz, and K-Pop group TWICE. With over 600,000 subscribers and more than 100 million views on his YouTube Channel, Brian's choreography has been reposted on many celebrity profiles including Bruno Mars, Calum Scott, Cardi B, Chris Brown, Daddy Yankee, Dawin, Hozier, Keith Urban, Nicki Minaj, Pia Mia, and Steve Aoki. Additionally, he has danced/choreographed for the LA Choreographer's Ball: Carnival, appeared on the Ellen Show, collaborated with YouTube creator: The Fitness Marshall, and has been featured on BuzzFeed, Showstopper, and A-Plus Network. Currently, Brian is a partner with DanceOn Network, teaches at dance studios around the world, and is the choreographer/instructor for the SKIP touring company.

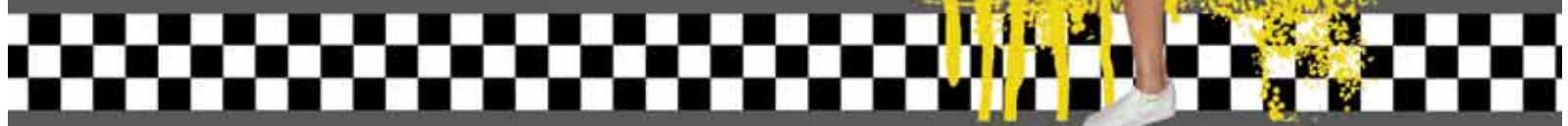


# Audrey Bordallo

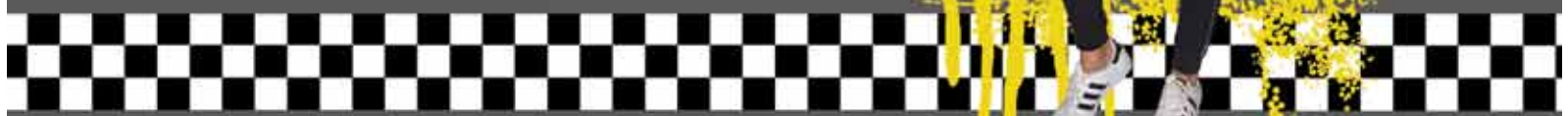
# Elizah Camacho

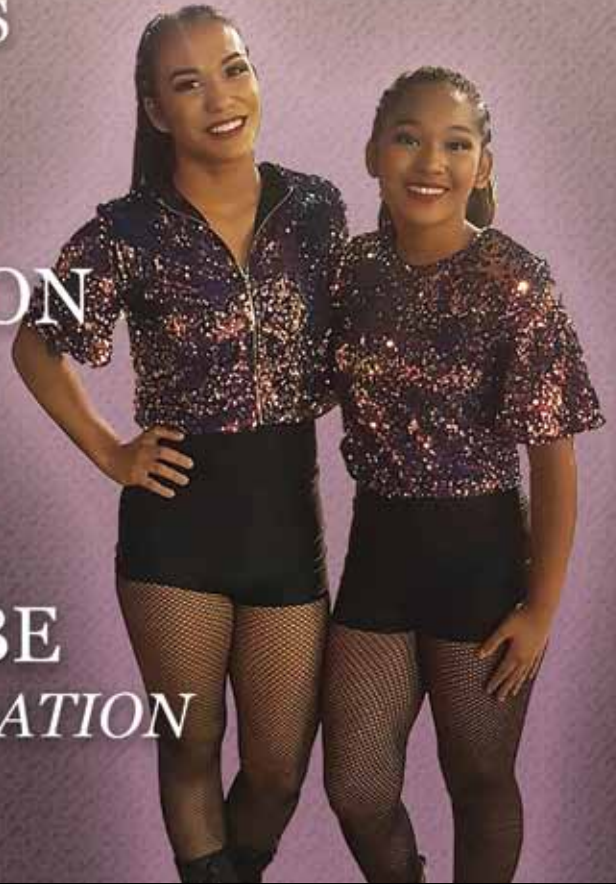

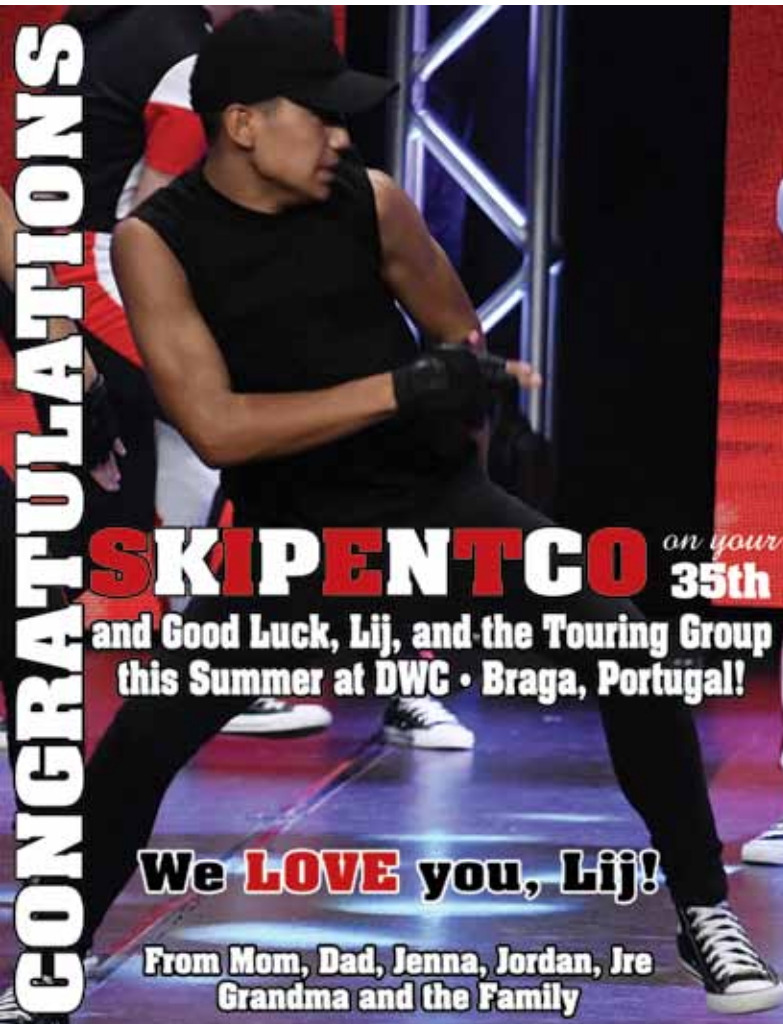
