

TERI & LEE KNAPP

Teri and Lee Knapp are the founders and directors of the non-profit organization, SKIP Entertainment Company. In 1983 there were few extracurricular programs for kids. The Knapps, along with Dan and Joyce McCauley, created several programs so their combined six kids would have nurturing activities. Children's Productions is known as the SKIP Entertainment Company. In addition to SKIP, and with their son Chad Knapp, they created additional dance programs to provide dance education to kids in Australia, New Zealand, Spain and the US Mainland including Sourcedance and Urban Empire. Sourcedance continues to work in conjunction with Choreographer's Carnival out of LA to produce shows in Sydney. The focus has always been to provide opportunities for kids to excel.

Teri has devoted her life to working with kids. She was a teacher and administrator for the Department of Education for 30 years. She was the GATE Academic and Visual & Performing Arts coordinator for over 20 years producing numerous musical productions.

Lee is the financial director for the organization. He has been in healthcare finance, business manager of a law firm and controller for two car dealerships since the 1980's.

Mr. and Mrs.Knapp have three grown sons, three daughters-in-law, three grandsons and four granddaughters. HISTORY

The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) is a GUAM SUCCESS STORY! SKIP originally started as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated in 1982, known as the Sunshine Kids in Production (SKIP). Prior to the birth of SKIP, Children's Productions staged a number of children's musicals. Soon the focus turned to dance, giving thousands of Guam's youth an opportunity to excel. Instructors and choreographers continue to come to Guam from Los Angeles and New York City to work with Guam's best. We want to especially thank all who have come to Guam to give our dancers the best training in the world! The list of choreographers who have come to Guam to choreograph for the SKIP Entertainment Company are the Who's Who of Dance including Ray Leeper, Tina D'Amato, Tabitha & Napoleon Dumo, Dee Caspary, Tony Czar, Tucker Barkley, Andre Fuentes (RIP), Gabe de Guzman, Stephen Tannos, Big Will Simmons, Alysha Percy and Cameron Lee.

The SKIP Dancers began touring in 1985 when the first group toured the U.S. Mainland and since that time have traveled to dance competitions and performances in the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe and Australia every year. In 1991, members of SKIP performed on International Star Search, aired in over 63 countries. Later that year, SKIP was once again selected to appear on Ed McMahon's Star Search. That same year, SKIP dancers appeared on the cover of PERFORMER'S EDGE, a national dance publication. From 1991 through 2022, SKIP won numerous National and International Dance Championships. One of the most exciting competitions was during the 1996 Jazz Dance World Congress held at the Kennedy Center where SKIP won the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award. Due to this honor, SKIP was selected as featured performers at the 1997 Jazz Dance World Congress in Weisbaden, Germany. International recognition was brought back to Guam once again when SKIP was honored by winning the Overall Dance Championship at the International Grand Prix Dance Festival in Cesena, Italy in July 2002, the Canadian National Finals in 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016 and the Czech Republic Dance Festival in 2007. In 2014, SKIP represented Guam at one of the most difficult and prestigious competition showcases in the world - the PULSE Showcase in Las Vegas. SKIP won one of the top awards and was invited back as a guest to showcase. In 2014, the group once again won the championship at the European Grand Prix in Barcelona Spain and performed at the prestigious HEAVEN beach club in Marbella Spain.

During the past several years, SKIP has continued to win top awards in five countries including the US, Canada, Australia, Czech Republic and Italy. SKIP was also selected to audition for America's Best Dance Crew and made it through to the final selection. For the past several years, SKIP dancers have teamed up with dancers from the US and Australia as a part of EMPIRE, THE CREW to win the Championships at the Battlegrounds Hip Hop Competitions in Australia.

The group has become well known on youtube - again representing Guam. During this past year - the choreography of Brian Esperon (along with the SKIP Dancers) has been recognized by TikTok as one of the most influential choreographers for the past year. He has also been recognized by Chris Brown, Nicki Minaj, Cardi B and Jason Derulo. In addition SKIP dancers were featured on the latest Steve Aoki Music Video. These are huge honors for our island dancers to be recognized as some of the best in the world.

SKIP has also been named as one of the top 50 dance studios in the entire United States by Dance Teacher magazine. Thousands from around the world are able to read about Guam's very own. SKIP Entertainment Company.

Prior to the Covid year(s), SKIP represented Guam at the 2019 Dance World Cup in Braga, Portugal. Over 20,000 competitors from 61 countries were competing for the <u>championship</u>. SKIP was named 1 st runner up and Brian Esperon was named as the top choreographer of the <u>entire competition</u>. In 2021, SKIP was able to attend the National Finals in Orlando where SKIP won the <u>championship</u> and received the highest score given at the Finals. Throughout the last couple of years, SKIP was able to present two very unique concerts: June 2021 at the Park N Play Outdoor Movie Theatre and in January 2022, the beautiful Taotao Tasi Stage was the performance venue. We were so happy to return to our Theatrical Home – the FD Phoenix Center for our June 2022 Concert!

In July 2022, SKIP won the Victory Cup over thousands of dancers at the Revolution National Championship in Anaheim. Later in the year, SKIP won top awards at the Battle Grounds in Sydney Australia.

SKIP will be returning to the International Dance Finals in July at the Prague Dance Festival in the Czech Republic








ELIZAH CAMACHO HIP HOP INSTRUCTOR






