HISTORY


The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) stands as a remarkable success story in Guam. Established in 1982 as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated, originally known as the Sunshine Kids in Production, SKIP evolved from staging children's musicals to focusing on dance, creating opportunities for thousands of Guam's youth. Instructors and choreographers from Los Angeles and New York City frequently visit Guam to offer world-class training, and we extend our heartfelt gratitude to all who have contributed to this mission.

The journey of SKIP has always transcended dance, fostering a constructive outlet for participation and enjoyment. It has grown into a nurturing environment that promotes values such as respect, commitment, teamwork, mutual support, self-confidence, and effective time management. Additionally, it offers young minds the chance to broaden their perspectives and embrace diverse cultures through travel. Since beginning their tours in 1985, SKIP Dancers have participated in competitions and performances across the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe, and Australia every year. In 1991, they gained international recognition by performing on International Star Search, which aired in over 63 countries, and they were selected to appear again on Ed McMahon's Star Search later that year. That same year, SKIP dancers graced the cover of the national dance publication PERFORMER'S EDGE. Between 1991 and 2024, SKIP garnered numerous National and International Dance Championships, highlighted by winning the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award at the Jazz Dance World Congress at the Kennedy Center. Most recently, they claimed the coveted Victory Cup at the Revolution National Championship and achieved the highest performance score at the Showstopper National finals.

We take great pride in the accomplishments of all those associated with the SKIP Touring Companies. Notably, our members have an impressive 95% college graduation rate. Today, SKIP alumni thrive in various fields, including education, healthcare, law, business, accounting, and counseling.

This summer, SKIP is excited to return to Canada to compete in the Dance World Cup event.







SECILIA UNPINGCO


