The first being to bring in the best training in the world, as SKIP welcomed Ray Leeper, Tina D'Amato, Al B, Tabitha and Napoleon, Dee Caspary, Glenn Packard, Andre Fuentes, Tony Czar, Tucker Barkley, Will da Beast, Anisha Gibbs, Melvin Timtim to name a few. They were and still are some of the best in the world. We also had to work twice as hard, as we didn't have all the regional comps to attend to help make us better at competitions.

When we say nothing has changed – the focus and goals have never changed since the inception. The goal of the SKIP Entertainment Dance Company is to provide a positive influence on the youth of Guam. Through dance, students have an opportunity to develop life-long values including commitment, self-discipline, timeliness, meeting deadlines, taking on challenges, living a healthy life-style, working towards individual potential, teamwork building and enjoying life. However, most important is the development of a deep sense of self esteem so that participants can have the courage to "reach for the stars", whether it be in dance, sports, academics or in the corporate board room. In addition, we have been so fortunate that dancers who have graduated from college continue to come back to give back. Following this tradition for the past three years Brian Esperon has come back to choreograph and direct the concerts. We also had a pleasant surprise when Dominic Cadiz was also able to come back to co-direct this concert. The S.K.I.P. History

The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) is a GUAM SUCCESS STORY! SKIP originally started as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated in 1982, known as the Sunshine Kids in Production (SKIP). Prior to the birth of SKIP, Children's Productions staged a number of children's musicals. Soon the focus turned to dance, giving thousands of Guam's youth an opportunity to excel. Instructors and choreographers continue to come to Guam from Los Angeles and New York City to work with Guam's best. We want to especially thank all who have come to Guam to give our dancers the best training in the world! The list of choreographers looks like the Who's Who of Dance!

The SKIP Dancers began touring in 1985 when the first group toured the U.S. Mainland and since that time have traveled to dance competitions and performances in the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe and Australia every year. In 1991, members of SKIP performed on International Star Search, aired in over 63 countries. Later that year, SKIP was once again selected to appear on Ed McMahon's Star Search. That same year, SKIP dancers appeared on the cover of PERFORMER'S EDGE, a national dance publication. From 1991 through 2010, SKIP has won numerous National and International Dance Championships. One of the most exciting competitions was during the 1996 Jazz Dance World Congress held at the Kennedy Center where SKIP won the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award. Due to this honor, SKIP was selected as featured performers at the 1997 Jazz Dance World Congress in Wiesbaden, Germany. International recognition was brought back to Guam once again when SKIP was honored by winning the Overall Dance Championship at the International Grand Prix Dance Festival in Cesena, Italy in July 2002, the Canadian National Finals in 2000 and 2004, and the Czech Republic Dance Festival in 2007.

SKIP has been named as one of the top 50 dance studios in the entire United States by Dance Teacher magazine. Thousands from around the world are able to read about Guam's very own, SKIP Entertainment Company.

During the past several years, SKIP has won top awards one in five countries including the US, Canada, Australia, Czech Republic and Italy. The numerous honors include winning the 2012 Grand Prix Championship in Cesena, Italy. Competing with groups representing 20 countries – SKIP was the panel of judges and audience favorites. In addition SKIP dancers also known as EMPIRE, THE CREW were selected to compete in Sydney Australia and were requested by the World of Dance Organization to showcase at the Honolulu finals. SKIP was also selected to audition for America's Best Dance Crew and made it through to the final selection. The group has become well known on YOUTUBE – again representing Guam. In addition, in July 2012, SKIP won one of the biggest awards in North America, the Dance World Cup in Montreal followed by winning the SHOWBIZ National Dance Championship in Daytona Beach in 2013. In 2014, SKIP represented Guam at one of the most difficult and prestigious competition showcases in the world – the PULSE Showcase in Las Vegas. The judges included Brian Friedman and Chris Judd. SKIP won one of the top awards and was invited back as a guest to showcase. This past year, the group once again won the championship at the European Grand Prix in Barcelona Spain and performed at the prestigious HEAVEN beach club in Marbella Spain. In October 2015, they returned to Australia and won the Young Guns Division Championship at the Battleground Hip Hop Competition in Brisbane.

SKIP will be returning to North America for the Showbiz National Championships in Daytona Florida and the Dance World Cup in Montreal.


MAKENZIE MILES

In October 2015, SKIP sent representatives to Brisbane, Australia to compete in the WORLD SU-PREMACY BAT-TLEGROUNDS. The competition was challenging and fierce. In the end, SKIP came out on top as CHAM-PIONS in the Young Guns Division. The dance crew consisted of Aaron Arizala. 





THE LEGACY will not be what it has become without Teri and Lee's belief and their love of our children. You both should be so proud as to THE LEGACY you have here





