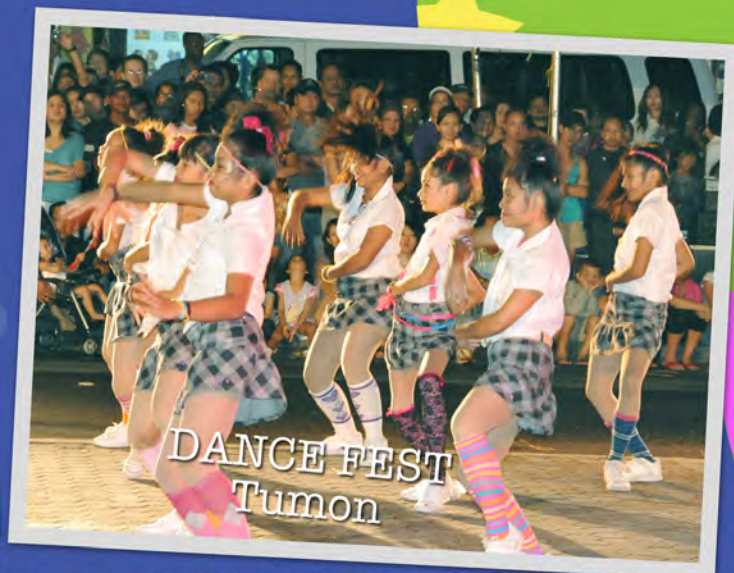
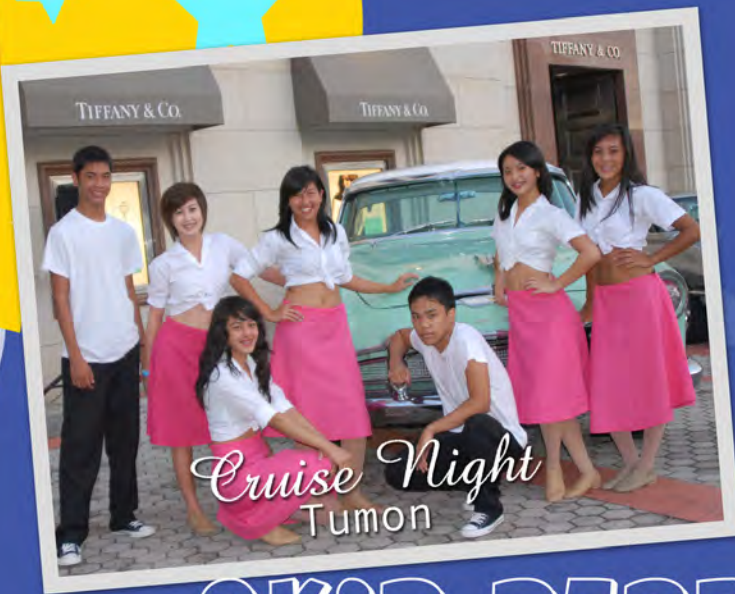

THE SKIP HISTORY

The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) is a GUAM SUCCESS STORY! SKIP originally started as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated in 1982, known as the Sunshine Kids in Production (SKIP). Prior to the birth of SKIP, Children's Productions staged a number of children's musicals. Soon the focus turned to dance, giving thousands of Guam's youth an opportunity to excel. Instructors and choreographers continue to come to Guam from Los Angeles and New York City to work with Guam's best.

Last July SKIP competed against some of the most talented dancers in the US. Little SKIP took top honors in the Petite Grand Championship at the Showbiz Nationals while the Teens and Seniors took second place in the Diamond Division. This honor followed winning the **ShowTime Grand Championships** in both the JR and SR divisions in Canada in 2008 and the **Crystal Cup 2007 Grand Prix**, awarded to the best dance company for all-inclusive performances at the Prague Dance Festival in 2007.

SKIP has been named as one of the top 50 dance studios in the entire United States by Dance Teacher magazine. Thousands from around the world are able to read about Guam's very own, SKIP Entertainment Company.

The SKIP Dancers began touring in 1985 when the first group toured the U.S. Mainland and since that time have traveled to dance competitions and performances in the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe and Australia every year. In 1991, members of SKIP performed on International Star Search, aired in over 63 countries. Later that year, SKIP was once again selected to appear on Ed McMahon's Star Search. That same year, SKIP dancers appeared on the cover of PERFORMER'S EDGE, a national dance publication.

From 1991 through 2006, SKIP has won numerous National and International Dance Championships. One of the most exciting competitions was during the 1996 Jazz Dance World Congress held at the Kennedy Center where SKIP won the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award. Due to this honor, SKIP was selected as featured performers at the 1997 Jazz Dance World Congress in Weisbaden, Germany. International recognition was brought back to Guam once again when SKIP was honored by winning the Overall Dance Championship at the International Grand Prix Dance Festival in Cesena, Italy in July 2002, the Canadian National Finals in 2000 and 2004.

THE SKIP STORY – MAKING DREAMS COME TRUE

Beyond the awards and honors.....are the dreams of hundreds of kids right here on our island. Dreams to work as a professional dancer, dreams to attend college on a dance scholarship, dreams to meet and be trained by some of the world's most famous dancers, dreams to perform on international stages, dreams to have your own television show..... and the dreams keep coming. These dreams have all come true! Many SKIP Dancers are or have been working as professional dancers including dancing in the King and I on Broadway, the Mikhail Baryshkinov White Oak Dance Tour, Celine Dion Show, Britney Spears Tour, Paulina Rubio Tour the Ricky Martin Tour, Celebrity Cruise Lines, Disney's High School Musical and as dance teachers. Many are or have attended colleges on dance scholarship to NYU, HPU and UH. SKIP dancers have met Mikhail Baryshnikov, and have trained with an Emmy Award winning choreographer (AC Ciula), an Emmy Award nominated and Michael Jackson's choreographer (Glenn Packard), the star of the movie, *You Got Served* (Christopher Jones), the choreographer for Britney Spears *Womanizer* and *Circus Videos* (Andre Fuentes), choreographers for *So You Think You Can Dance* (Tabitha & Napoleon Dumo), the assistant choreographer for New Kids on the Block and Britney Spears (Tony Czar), the lead dancer for many music videos including Britney Spears, Janet Jackson, Miley Cyrus, Ava, Sean Kingston, Cheetah Girls, Omarion, Sean Paul & more (Tucker Barkley). These young dancers have danced on the Star Search Stage, the Kennedy Center Stage where they won the International Choreographer Award, the International Theatre in Italy and the National Theatre of Prague. In addition, the SKIP dancers were the featured dancers in the Manila based television series, Club TV. Yes Dreams do come true!

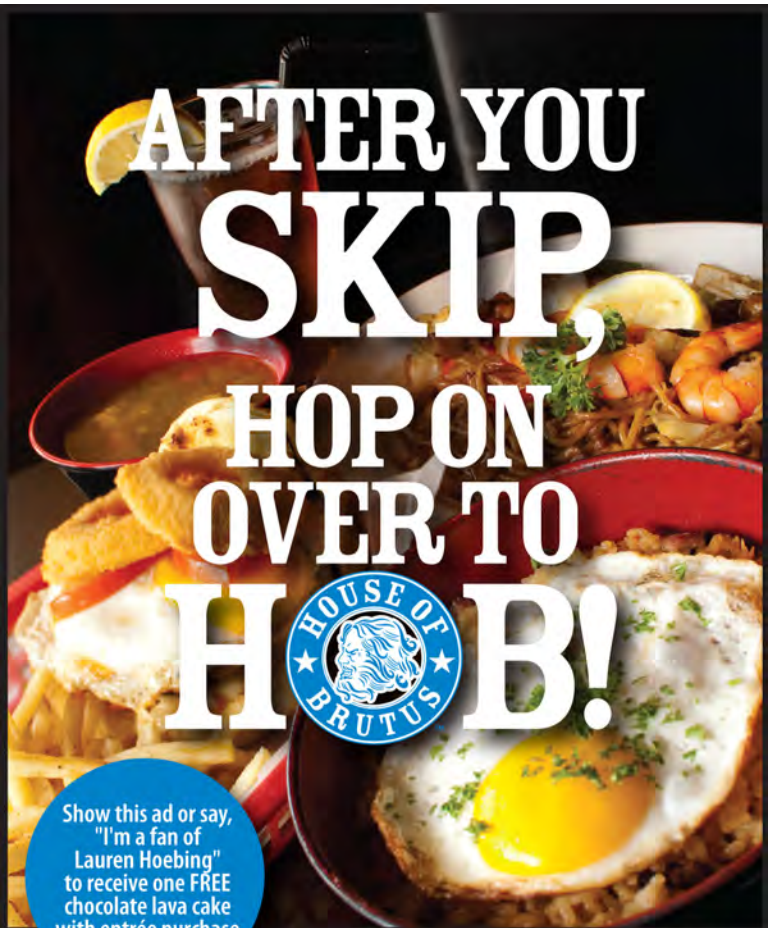

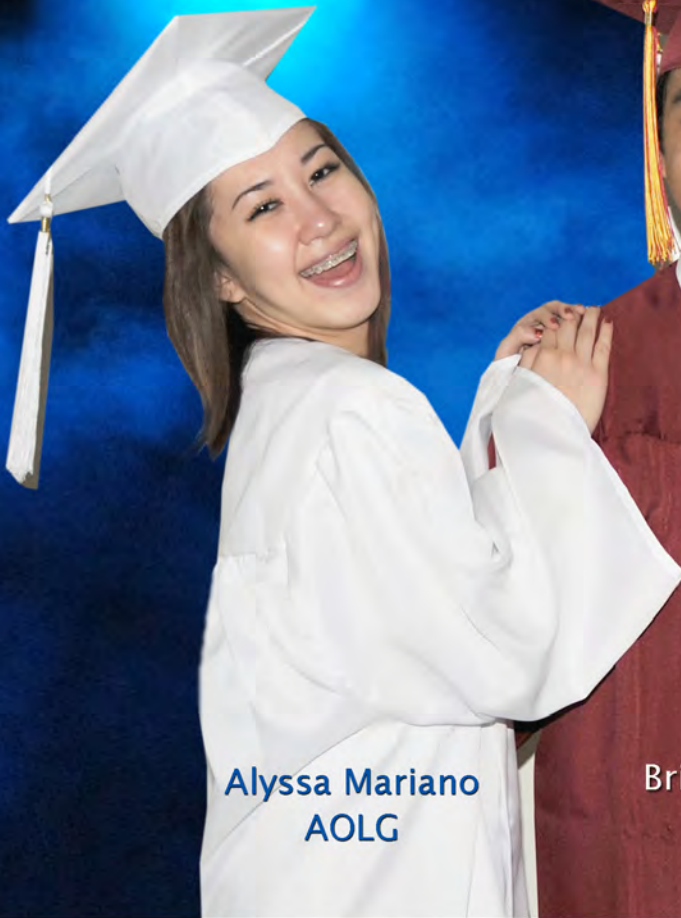

Dance institution celebrates 25 years

From jazz to hip-hop, ballet and more, the dancers of SKIP marked 25 years of blood, sweat and hard work with the company's annual showcase, "For the Love of Dance," which concluded yesterday. Through good times and bad, a company that started as an idea between two friends to keep their children busy after school has blossomed into an organization that has earned recognition for its excellence across the nation.

"It's about giving kids the opportunity to excel. It's about giving them the tools for life," said Teri Krupp, director of SKIP, or Sunshine Kids in Production.

Krupp wasn't kidding — the show was a lesson in the company's history and was nothing short of fantastic. The youngest children, though not as proficient in their technique, are nothing short of adorable. The young teens show incredible promise in their talents, and it's hard to be anything but envious of the seniors. Combined, the show turned out to be everything that was promised.

SKIP was founded 25 years ago on Guam to give kids the opportunity to succeed, according to Krupp. Krupp says her involvement with SKIP began with her own children in 1984, since there was little at the time to occupy young kids. The military soccer league had just begun and was small, there were no other sports leagues, there were no swim teams and few extracurricular activities. So the thought occurred to her to help organize some form of activity to keep kids busy after school. SKIP originally started as a program of Children's Productions, where Krupp and Joyce McCauley
