They could never say NO to her.

Through the last 13 years battling cancer, again there was never a complaint. She spent her time helping others and never worrying about herself. She always took the time to start a conversation with anyone and everyone she met, no matter where she was. She chose to live every day in happiness and laughed more than any person we have ever known.

Her legacy of being such an inspiration will not only live on in Jose, Carlo, Ray, and Tara and their spouses and kids, but through each of the SKIP families that spent many years with her.

We love and honor you Carina Leon Guerrero. There will never be another you! We will miss you dearly but what you have taught us will live on forever! We are the fortunate ones to have had you in our lives. You had a very special part in making SKIP what it is today.



The SKIP History

The SKIP Entertainment Company (SKIP) is a GUAM SUCCESS STORY! SKIP originally started as a project of Children's Productions, Incorporated in 1982, known as the Sunshine Kids in Production (SKIP). Prior to the birth of SKIP, Children's Productions staged a number of children's musicals. Soon the focus turned to dance, giving thousands of Guam's youth an opportunity to excel. Instructors and choreographers continue to come to Guam from Los Angeles and New York City to work with Guam's best.

The SKIP Dancers began touring in 1985 when the first group toured the U.S. Mainland and since that time have traveled to dance competitions and performances in the U.S. Mainland, Canada, Europe and Australia every year. In 1991, members of SKIP performed on International Star Search, aired in over 63 countries. Later that year, SKIP was once again selected to appear on Ed McMahon's Star Search. That same year, SKIP dancers appeared on the cover of PERFORMER'S EDGE, a national dance publication. From 1991 through 2012, SKIP has won numerous National and International Dance Championships. One of the most exciting competitions was during the 1996 Jazz Dance World Congress held at the Kennedy Center where SKIP won the International Choreographic Leo's Gold Award. Due to this honor, SKIP was selected as featured performers at the 1997 Jazz Dance World Congress in Weisbaden, Germany. International recognition was brought back to Guam once again when SKIP was honored by winning the Overall Dance Championship at the International Grand Prix Dance Festival in Cesena, Italy in July 2002, the Canadian National Finals in 2000 and 2004, and the Czech Republic Dance Festival in 2007.

SKIP has been named as one of the top 50 dance studios in the entire United States by Dance Teacher magazine. Thousands from around the world are able to read about Guam's very own, SKIP Entertainment Company.

During the past two years, SKIP has received numerous honors including winning the 2011 Grand Prix Championship in Cecena, Italy. Competing with groups representing 20 countries – SKIP was the panel of judges and audience favorites. In addition SKIP dancers also known as EMPIRE, THE CREW were selected to compete in Sydney, Australia and were requested by the World of Dance Organization to showcase at the Honolulu finals. SKIP was also selected to audition for America's Best Dance Crew. The group along with Lil Bigz from LA, made it through to the final selection. The group has become well known on youtube – again representing Guam. In addition, in July 2012, SKIP won one of the biggest awards in North America, the Dance World Cup in Montreal.

The SKIP Story

Beyond the awards and honors......are the dreams of hundreds of kids right here on our island. Dreams to work as a professional dancer, dreams to attend college on a dance scholarship, dreams to meet and be trained by some of the world's most famous dancers, dreams to perform on international stages, dreams to have your own television show..... and the dreams keep coming. These dreams have all come true! Many SKIP Dancers are or have been working as professional dancers including dancing in the King and I on Broadway, the Mikhail Baryshkinov White Oak Dance Tour, Celine Dion Show, Britney Spears Tour, Paulina Rubio Tour the Ricky Martin Tour, Celebrity Cruise Lines, Disney's High School Musical and as dance teachers all around the world. Many are or have attended prestigious universities on dance scholarships. SKIP dancers have met Mikhail Baryshnikov, and have trained with an Emmy Award winning choreographer (AC Ciula), an Emmy Award nominated and Michael Jackson's choreographer (Glenn Packard), the star of the movie, You Got Served (Christopher Jones), the choreographer for Britney Spears Womanizer and Circus Videos (Andre Fuentes), choreographers for So You Think You Can Dance (Tabitha & Napoleon Dumo), the assistant choreographer for New Kids on the Block and Britney Spears (Tony Czar), the lead dancer for many music videos including Britney Spears, Janet Jackson, Miley Cirus, Ava, Sean Kingston, Cheetah Girls, Omarion, Sean Paul & more (Tucker Barkley), dancer for Janet Jackson, Christina Aguilera, Britney Spears, Ricky Martin, Pink, Mya, Snoop Dogg, The Ying Yang Twins, Kylie Minogue, The Black Eyed Peas and Nicki Minaj (Anthony Garza).

These young dancers have danced on the Star Search Stage, the Kennedy Center Stage where they won the International Choreographer Award, the International Theatre in Italy and the National Theatre of Prague. In addition, the SKIP dancers were the featured dancers in the Manila based television series, Club TV. Being recognized by America's Best Dance Crew as one of the best dance groups in the nation was one of the highlights of the past two years. Yes Dreams do come true!








CHAD KNAPP


ROCHE SELGUERA
